UC San Diego values the privacy of our community. Article 15 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) (GDPR) grants individuals in the European Economic Area the right to access and correct their personal data, and in some cases to erase or restrict to processing of their personal data held by UC San Diego. We will do our best to comply with the requests we receive. However, we will not be able to delete information that we are otherwise required by law or UC Policy to maintain. **Please note that we will not be able to honor requests to delete official academic or employment records.**
